





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

as of 04 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 April 2024 at around 7AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army (PA) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of 63 families or 154 persons are affected in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

There are 63 families or 154 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).
