



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Umiray, Dingalan, Aurora

as of 27 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2024, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Pinamaypayan, Brgy. Umiray, Dingalan, Aurora between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) resulting in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **264 families** or **1,135 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Umiray**, **Dingalan**, **Aurora** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **67 families** or **268 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱302,280.00** worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex C).
