

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clan Feud Incident in Brgy. Banucagon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato

as of 26 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 24 April 2024 at around 4:30 PM, a clan feud incident due to land dispute between two (2) conflict families transpired in Brgy. Banucagon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato which resulted in the displacement of the families and individuals in the area.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **171 families** or **855 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Banucagon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **88 families** or **440 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Municipal Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Banucagon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **95 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **107 families** or **535 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Banucagon, Pigkawayan, North Cotabato** (see Annex D).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱661,010.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱611,010.00** from **DSWD** and **₱50,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
