

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 14 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 April 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:15 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **36 families** or **106 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **36 families** or **106 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall of Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **19** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱249,408.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
