

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City as of 11 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2024 at around 3:47 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, 4, 5, Brgy. 20, Isla Puting Bato, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:00 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **900 families** or **3,600 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **900 families** or **3,600 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Delpa Sports Complex** in **Brgy. 20, Manila City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **300 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 20, Manila City** (see Annex C).
