





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City

as of 11 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2024 at around 3:47 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, 4, 5, Brgy. 20, Isla Puting Bato, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:00 AM.

A total of **900 families** or **3,600 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 900 families or 3,600 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Delpan Sports Complex in Brgy. 20, Manila City (see Annex B).
