

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2024 at around 11:33 AM, a fire incident occurred at Parola Compound, Brgy. 275, Zone 25, San Nicolas, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:14 PM.
