

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 335, Manila City as of 08 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2024 at around 3:19 PM, a fire incident occurred at Tomas Mapua, Lope De Vega and Anacleto St., Brgy. 335, Zone 34, Sta. Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:13 PM.
