as of 14 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2024 at around 4:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 5:02 PM.

One (1) family or two (2) persons are affected in Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons temporarily staying with their friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱5,433.30 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱4,733.30 from DSWD and ₱700.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
