

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol

as of 14 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2024 at around 4:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 5:02 PM.

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** temporarily staying with their friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Anonang, Buenavista, Bohol** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,433.30** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱4,733.30** from **DSWD** and **₱700.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
