

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Balanti-an, Balasan, Iloilo

as of 21 April 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire occurred in Brgy. Balanti-an, Balasan, Iloilo and was declared fire out at around 12:00 PM. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community, with ten (10) residential houses were engulfed by the fire.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, closely coordinates with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Balasan, Iloilo, for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

A total of **10 families** or **50 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Balanti-an, Balasan, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **50 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Balanti-an Covered Court** in **Balasan, Iloilo** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Balantian, Balasan, Iloilo** (see Annex C).
