### I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2024 at around 5:41 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Baresbes, Dingras, Ilocos Norte.

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Baresbes, Dingras, Ilocos Norte (see Annex A).

### **III.** Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

**One (1) family** or **three (3) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Baresbes**, **Dingras**, **Ilocos Norte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱11,030.25 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱7,530.25 from DSWD and ₱3,500.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
