

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Batis, San Juan City as of 17 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2024 at around 5:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Manalo St., Brgy. Batis, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 7:57 PM.

A total of **120 families** or **458 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **120 families** or **458 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex C).
