as of 17 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2024 at around 5:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Manalo St., Brgy. Batis, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 7:57 PM.

A total of 120 families or 458 persons are affected in Brgy. Batis, San Juan City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 120 families or 458 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. Batis, San Juan City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Batis**, **San Juan City** (see Annex C).
