I. Situation Overview

On 03 April 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱20,638.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱12,338.60** from **DSWD** and **₱8,300.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
