I. Situation Overview

On 03 April 2024 at around 3:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Bisocol, City of Alaminos, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P20,638.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **P12,338.60** from **DSWD** and **P8,300.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
