

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2024 at around 12:00 MN, a fire incident occurred in Barangay Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 1:00 AM.

**One (1) family** or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,200.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱800.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱1,400.00** from the **Office of Civil Defense (OCD)** (see Annex C).
