I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2024 at around 12:00 MN, a fire incident occurred in Barangay Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 1:00 AM.

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Capt. Claudio, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}2,200.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}800.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) and \$\mathbb{P}1,400.00\$ from the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) (see Annex C).
