I. Situation Overview

On 05 April 2024 at around 1:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Culasian, Capoocan, Leyte.

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Culasian, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex A).

One house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Culasian, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex B).

A total of **₱8,809.31** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex C).
