



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lipit Tomeeng, San Fabian, Pangasinan

as of 16 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 April 2024 around 1:30 in the afternoon in Brgy. Lipit Tomeeng, San Fabian, Pangasinan, one (1) residential house was gutted by fire and was declared totally damaged. The affected family established temporary dwelling space within their premises.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Fabian, Pangasinan, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Lipit Tomeeng, San Fabian, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Lipit Tomeeng, San Fabian, Pangasinan (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱10,588.60 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of ₱8,588.60 from DSWD and ₱2,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
