
DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lobong, San Jacinto, Pangasinan

as of 16 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 April 2024 at around 11:10 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Lobong, San Jacinto, Pangasinan. The affected individual, who is living alone, sought temporary shelter with his relatives in the nearby locality.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of San Jacinto, Pangasinan, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

One (1) family or **one (1) person** are affected in **Brgy. Lobong, San Jacinto, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **one (1) family** or **one (1) person** temporarily staying with relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Lobong, San Jacinto, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱11,588.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱8,588.60** from the **DSWD** and **₱3,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
