

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental as of 15 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 April 2024 at around 4:14 PM, a fire incident occurred at Upper Palalan, Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 5:27 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **26 families** or **116 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **26 families** or **116 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Lumbia Covered Court** in **Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **19 houses** were damaged; of which, **16** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱76,366.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
