## I. Situation Overview

On 16 March 2024 at around 9:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lubnak, Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte.

A total of three (3) families or 11 persons are affected in Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, llocos Norte (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}46,120.75\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}18,120.75\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}28,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
