

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte

as of 02 April 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 March 2024 at around 9:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lubnak, Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **three (3) families** or **11 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Manalpac, Solsona, Ilocos Norte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱46,120.75** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱18,120.75** from **DSWD** and **₱28,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
