I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2024 at around 5:05 AM, a fire incident occurred at #111 Sto. Rosario, Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 6:02 AM.

A total of **32 families** or **130 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **130 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Plainview Elementary School** in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱225,078.35** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
