#### I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2024 at around 5:05 AM, a fire incident occurred at #111 Sto. Rosario, Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 6:02 AM.

A total of **32 families** or **130 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 32 families or 130 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Plainview Elementary School in Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱225,078.35 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex F).
