I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 12AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 4, Brgy. Ponggo, Nagtipunan, Quirino.

A total of three (3) families or 11 persons are affected in Brgy. Ponggo, Nagtipunan, Quirino (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were partially damaged in Brgy. Ponggo, Nagtipunan, Quirino (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P41,061.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
