

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City as of 22 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2024 at around 4:29 AM, a fire incident occurred at West Bank, Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM.

A total of **80 families** or **320 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex A).

There are **80 families** or **320 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Hunters ROTC Building** in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex B).

A total of **50 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Rosario, Pasig City** (see Annex C).
