I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:16 PM.

A total of **167 families** or **598 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **167 families** or **598 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **City Central Night High School** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **82 houses** were damaged; of which, **78** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex C).
