## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City**

as of 05 April 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 03 April 2024 at around 8:37 PM, a fire incident occurred at Tramo II, Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 10:10 PM. The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals in the community wherein a total of 12 residential houses were completely destroyed by the incident.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **40 families** or **112 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **40 families** or **112 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Dionisio, Parañaque City** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱154,512.00** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
