I. Situation Overview

On 26 March 2024 at around 1:49 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio 2, Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:11 PM.

A total of 21 families or 90 persons are affected in Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 21 families or 90 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Filimon Javier Day Care Center in Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱147,942.83 worth of assistance was provided by DSWD to the affected families (see Annex E).
