

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City

as of 08 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 March 2024 at around 1:49 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio 2, Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:11 PM.

A total of **21 families** or **90 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **21 families** or **90 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Filimon Javier Day Care Center** in **Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. San Jose, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex D).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱147,942.83** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
