

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte

as of 25 April 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 April 2024 at around 1:50 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **18 families** or **75 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **22 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **13 families** or **53 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **18 families** or **75 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Sto. Niño, Capoocan, Leyte** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱337,217.58** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
