

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental

as of 09 April 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 March 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Tabalogo in Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 PM.
