





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident within the boundaries of Brgy. Manuyo Dos, Las Piñas City and Brgy. Isidro, Parañaque City

as of 04 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 April 2024 at around 6:58 PM, a fire incident occurred within the boundaries of Brgy. Manuyo Dos, Las Piñas City and Brgy. Isidro in Parañaque City. The fire was declared out the next day at around 3:43 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 330 families or 1,016 persons are affected in Brgy. Manuyo Dos, Las Piñas City and Brgy. Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 330 families or 1,016 persons currently taking temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Brgy. Manuyo Dos, Las Piñas City and Brgy. Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 174 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Manuyo Dos, Las Piñas City and Brgy. Isidro, Parañaque City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P699,071.30** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱168.37 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) available at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱4.55 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 101,508 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 48,076 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 53,432 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 28,999 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱402.43 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
