

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Whirlwind Incident in Brgy. Lumponid, Midsalip, Zamboanga del Sur

as of 26 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2024 at around 2:45 PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in Brgy. Lumponid, Midsalip, Zamboanga del Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **65 families** or **285 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lumponid, Midsalip, Zamboanga del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **65 families** or **285 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **63 houses** were damaged; of which, **11** are **totally damaged** and **52** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lumponid, Midsalip, Zamboanga del Sur** (see Annex C).
