

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental as of 17 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 April 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 1:15 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **47 families** or **116 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **10 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall of Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **19** are **totally damaged** and **seven (7)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 18 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱527,246.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱325,616.00** from **DSWD** and **₱201,630.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
