





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City

as of 12 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 April 2024 at around 3:47 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, 4, 5, Isla Puting Bato, Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:08 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **673 families** or **2,306 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 20, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 673 families or 2,306 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Delpan Sports Complex in Brgy. 20, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 300 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 20, Manila City (see Annex C).
