

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City

17 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2024 at around 11:33 AM, a fire incident occurred at Parola Compound, Brgy. 275, Zone 25, San Nicolas, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:14 PM.

A total of **129 families** or **454 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **129 families** or **454 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Pedro Guevarra Elementary School** in **Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **129 houses** were damaged; of which, **100** are **totally damaged** and **29** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex C).
