17 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 April 2024 at around 11:33 AM, a fire incident occurred at Parola Compound, Brgy. 275, Zone 25, San Nicolas, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 1:14 PM.

A total of 129 families or 454 persons are affected in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 129 families or 454 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Pedro Guevarra Elementary School in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 129 houses were damaged; of which, 100 are totally damaged and 29 are partially damaged in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City (see Annex C).
