

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Batis, San Juan City as of 18 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2024 at around 5:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Manalo St., Brgy. Batis, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 7:57 PM.

A total of **120 families** or **458 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **120 families** or **458 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱243,318.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
