

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pinamula, Kibawe, Bukidnon

15 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 March 2024 at around 12PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pinamula, Kibawe, Bukidnon.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region X, together with the Local Government unit (LGU) of Kibawe, Bukidnon, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **three (3) families** or **15 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pinamula, Kibawe, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **15 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3)** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pinamula, Kibawe, Bukidnon** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱17,519.34** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱4,019.34** from **DSWD** and **₱13,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
