





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City

as of 24 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 April 2024 at around 5:05 AM, a fire incident occurred at #111 Sto. Rosario, Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 6:02 AM.

The incident resulted in the complete destruction of 15 residential houses, displacing 32 families equivalent to 130 individuals who are currently staying at the Plainview Elementary School in Mandaluyong City.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region, promptly provided relief assistance in the form of Food and Non-Food Items (FNIs) to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

A total of **32 families** or **130 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **32 families** or **130 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **The Plainview Elementary School** in **Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Plainview, Mandaluyong City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P246,890.51.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
