





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu

as of 09 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2024 at around 12:27 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:30 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30 families** or **110 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion**, **Toledo City**, **Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 15 families or 66 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Barba Sports Complex in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **15 families** or **44 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 30 families or 110 persons displaced in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 16 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}753,375.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}623,485.00\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}69,890.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and \$\mathbb{P}60,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Annex H).

Poblacion to assist the LGU on Camp Management.
