

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Batis, San Juan City as of 22 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 April 2024 at around 5:25 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Manalo St., Brgy. Batis, San Juan City. The fire was declared out at around 7:57 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **190 families** or **695 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **122 families** or **467 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **68 families** or **228 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **190 families** or **695 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **40 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Batis, San Juan City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱325,596.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
