





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Linao, Minglanilla, Cebu

as of 07 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 April 2024 at around 3:20 AM, a fire broke out at Brgy. Linao, Minglanilla, Cebu, escalating to a second alarm before being extinguished at 4:37 AM. The estimated damage has reached a total of ₱2,205,000.00, affecting 64 families equivalent to 224 individuals.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Minglanilla, Cebu, actively engaged in the response operation and promptly conducted relief distribution, profiling of the affected population, and camp management.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **64 families** or **241 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Linao**, **Minglanilla**, **Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 46 families or 178 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Lipata Central Elementary School Covered Court in Brgy. Lipata, Minglanilla, Cebu (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **18 families** or **63 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **64 families** or **241 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Linao**, **Minglanilla**, **Cebu** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **64 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Linao**, **Minglanilla**, **Cebu** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}2,416,126.75\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}1,154,306.75\$ from the DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}1,261,820.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).

04 April 2024	 DSWD FO VII facilitated the distribution of Food and Non-Food Items (FNIs) composed of ready-to-eat meals, water, hygiene kits, and sleeping kits to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

b. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

6 April 2024	DSWD FO VII's DRMD CCCM Focal Person, Ms. Mildred F. Abela, coordinated with the Camp Management Committee of the Lipata Elementary School Evacuation Center to oversee the management of available facilities inside the evacuation center, protection initiatives for the IDPs, data validation and monitoring.
04 April 2024	 DSWD FO VII assessed the current condition and situation of the displaced families in the evacuation center. DSWD FO VII Municipal Action Team were deployed to the evacuation center to assist the LGU on Camp Management.
