II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of $\mathbf{3 0}$ families or $\mathbf{1 0 9}$ persons are affected in Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

## Inside Evacuation Center

There are eight (8) families or 29 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Barangay Lumbia Covered Court in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 21 houses were damaged; of which, 15 are totally damaged and six (6) are partially damaged in Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of P320,611.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, P244.245.00 from DSWD and P76,366.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
