



DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 29 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 April 2024 at around 4:14 PM, a fire incident occurred at Upper Palalan, Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 5:27 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30 families** or **109 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **29 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Barangay Lumbia Covered Court** in **Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21** houses were damaged; of which, **15** are totally damaged and six (6) are partially damaged in Brgy. Lumbia, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱320,611.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱244.245.00** from **DSWD** and **₱76,366.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 322,077 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 162,854 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 159,223 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 46,885 FFPs available at DSWD FO X.
- ₱422.22 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.
