





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu

as of 14 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2024 at around 12:27 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:30 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, together, with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Toledo City, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **40 families** or **152 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 23 families or 68 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Barba Sports Complex in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **17 families** or **84 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 40 families or 152 persons displaced in Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **16 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion, Toledo City, Cebu** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}949,816.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}787,726.00\$ from the DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}69,890.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), \$\mathbb{P}32,000.00\$ from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and \$\mathbb{P}60,000.00\$ from other Partners (see Annex H).
