





DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City

as of 18 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **274 families** or **738 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **56 families** or **129 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **City Central Night High School** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **218 families** or **609 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **274 families** or **738 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **91 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱4,489,745.10 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱2,222,185.10 from DSWD and ₱2,267,560.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
